Some important statistics to consider; did you know that the disability market touches 53% of consumers and represents a huge opportunity for business. Studies reveal that 97% of employees who have disabilities rate average or above in safety. 86% of employees who have a disability have average to above attendance records. Retention rates are 72% higher among people who have disabilities. 78% of Canadians are more than likely to buy a product or service from a business that hires people who have disabilities.
