A teen in St. Marys is seeking an overnight Support Worker, who will be accountable to both him and his family in regards to dignity, respect and quality of services. His worker is to ensure his safety and routine at all times, and is able to catch some 'zzzs' when he is soundly sleeping. This position is to cover an 18-month leave and will include a regular schedule to include a variety of weekdays, weekends, and statutory holidays, for an average of **36.5 hrs per week**. *Note: Contracted positions are not eligible for full time benefits.*
